Domains like **ledger-live.org** or **https://ledger-live.org** are **not official Ledger Live sources**. Scammers often register domain names that look similar to trusted services to trick users into downloading fake software or entering sensitive information. Legitimate Ledger communication will never ask you to enter your **24-word recovery phrase** on a website — that phrase should only be entered directly into your Ledger device when restoring a wallet. Always make sure you are accessing verified Ledger resources and avoid entering private keys or recovery phrases into any unknown site.

Final Thoughts

While terms like **ledger live staking** and **ledger live stake** refer to legitimate features within the official Ledger Live app that let you earn rewards on your crypto, names like **ledger-live.org** or **https://ledger-live.org** should raise caution.
