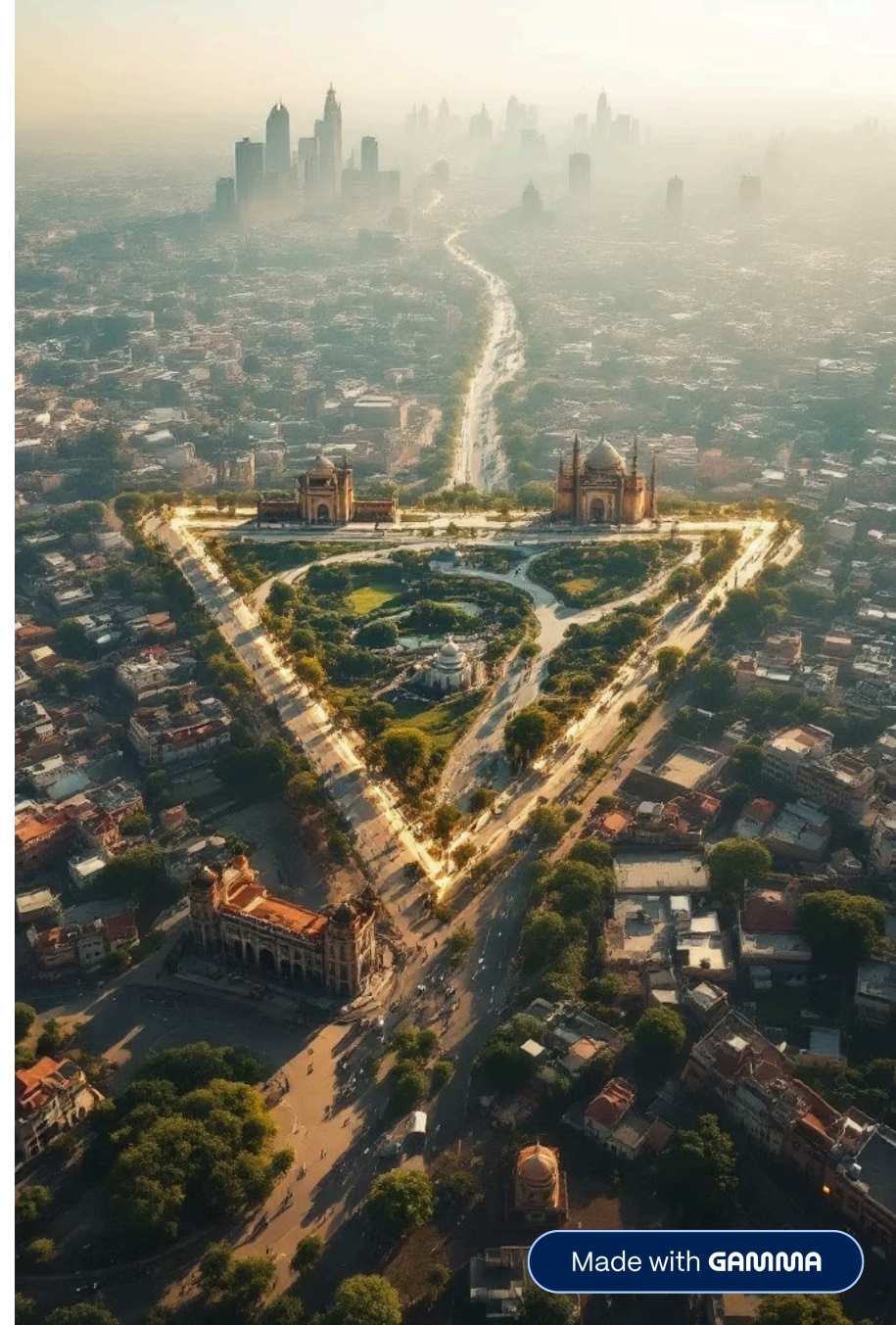


# The Golden Triangle: A 5-Day Indian Adventure

## Your Day in Agra

Check into your hotel, then explore the **Taj Mahal**—a UNESCO World Heritage site and one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Visit the elegant **Tomb of Itmad-ud-daulah** ("Baby Taj"), then discover **Agra Fort**, a massive red sandstone fortress showcasing Mughal military architecture.

### Taj Mahal

A marble masterpiece built by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal.

### Itmad-ud-daulah

An exquisite tomb known as the "Baby Taj" for its intricate pietra dura inlay work.

### Agra Fort

A UNESCO site featuring palaces, mosques, and halls where Mughal emperors once ruled.



# Day 3: Jaipur – The Pink City Beckons

## 1 — Early Departure

After an early breakfast, begin your journey to Jaipur (approximately 240 km, 3.5 hours).

## 2 — Historic Stop

En route, visit Fatehpur Sikri, the abandoned red sandstone capital of Mughal Emperor Akbar.

## 3 — Arrival

Reach Jaipur and check into your hotel to rest and prepare for exploration.

## 4 — First Sights

Begin exploring the "Pink City," named for its distinctive terracotta-colored buildings, starting with the iconic Hawa Mahal.

- Nahargarh Fort: Panoramic views of the Pink City at sunset
