Experience a serene sunset view of the Taj Mahal from across the Yamuna River. This tranquil garden offers the perfect frame for photographing the monument's reflection.

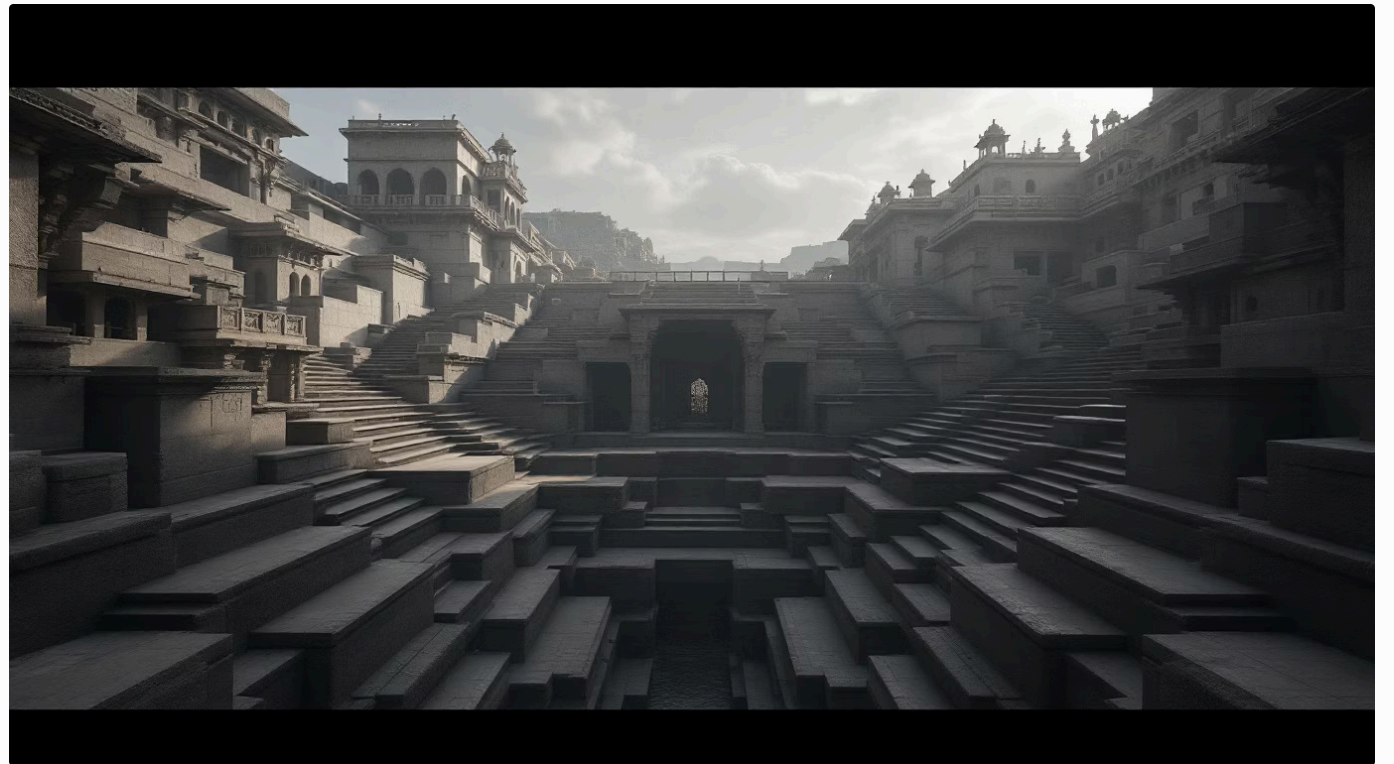
Travel via the modern Yamuna Expressway, connecting Delhi and Agra in comfort whilst journeying through India's heartland.

Morning: Abhaneri

En route to Jaipur, make a fascinating stop at Chand Baori, one of the world's largest and deepest stepwells. Carved into the earth over 1,000 years ago, this architectural marvel features 3,500 perfectly symmetrical steps descending 13 storeys.

The geometric precision served both practical and spiritual purposes—providing water during droughts whilst offering a cool sanctuary for meditation and community gatherings.



Afternoon: The Pink City

Arrive in Jaipur, Rajasthan's capital, where pink-hued buildings glow in the afternoon light. Established in 1727 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, the city was painted terracotta pink to welcome a visiting prince—and the tradition continues today.

Prepare for tomorrow's royal exploration with an evening at leisure, perhaps enjoying traditional Rajasthani cuisine or shopping for textiles and jewellery.

Day 4: Jaipur - The Pink City's Royal Splendour

Amber Fort

Ascend to this hilltop fortress renowned for artistic interiors featuring mirror work, frescoes, and intricate carvings. Explore Sheesh Mahal's mirror palace where a single candle illuminates thousands of glass fragments.

Jantar Mantar

Marvel at this 18th-century astronomical observatory featuring massive stone instruments that accurately tracked celestial movements. Each structure served specific scientific purposes, demonstrating remarkable engineering knowledge.

Johari Bazaar

Immerse yourself in vibrant markets offering precious gemstones, traditional textiles, handicrafts, and Rajasthani jewellery. Bargain with skilled merchants and discover treasures to remember your journey.

City Palace
