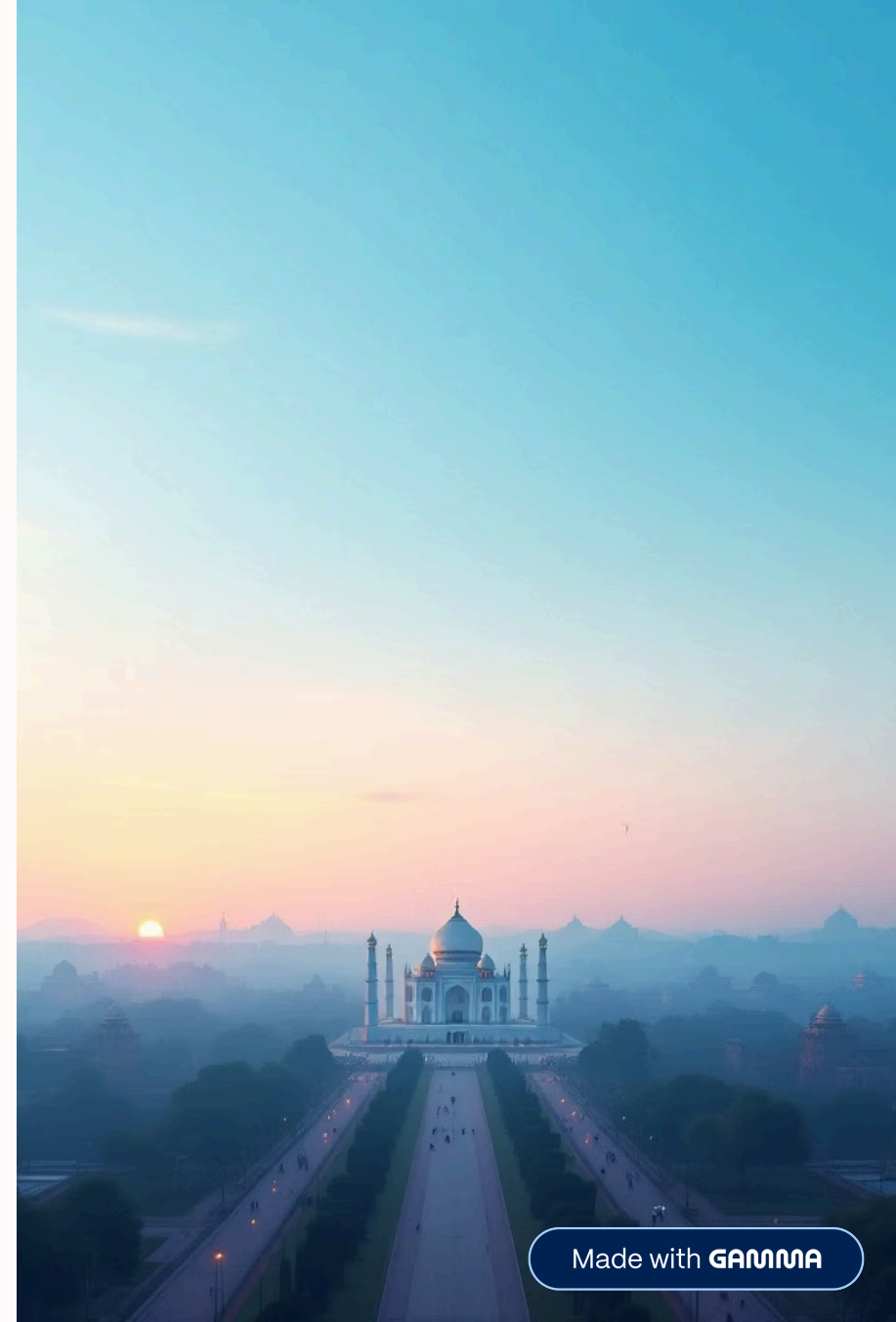


The Golden Triangle: A 5-Day Indian Adventure

Chand Baori Stepwell

The Pink City

Arrive in Jaipur, Rajasthan's capital, renowned for its distinctive pink sandstone architecture and regal heritage. The colour symbolises hospitality, earning its famous nickname.

Day 4: Jaipur - Forts, Palaces, and Bazaars

Amber Fort

Ascend to this magnificent hilltop fortress, renowned for artistic interiors featuring mirror work, intricate carvings, and stunning architecture blending Hindu and Mughal styles.

City Palace

Visit the sprawling complex combining Rajput and Mughal architecture, housing museums with royal artefacts, manuscripts, and the world's largest silver vessels.

Jantar Mantar

Explore the astronomical observatory built by Maharaja Jai Singh II, featuring 19 architectural instruments for measuring time, predicting eclipses, and tracking celestial bodies.

Hawa Mahal

Admire the iconic Palace of Winds with its distinctive honeycomb facade of 953 windows, designed to allow royal women to observe street festivals while remaining unseen.

Johari Bazaar

Immerse yourself in the vibrant market famous for precious gemstones, traditional jewellery, textiles, and exquisite handicrafts showcasing Rajasthani artistry.
